During the 2019-20 season Jewish Seniors Alliance Empowerment Series planned to present four events co-sponsored with four different community groups. The Programme Committee had chosen the theme "Be Inspired" for the four events.

The first in the series, presented with the Sholom Aleichem Seniors of the Vancouver Peretz Centre was held on Nov. 29th and was entitled, "Be Inspired through Story and Song". Shanie Levin read a number of stories on the theme and Myrna Rabinowitz sang songs that continued the theme.
